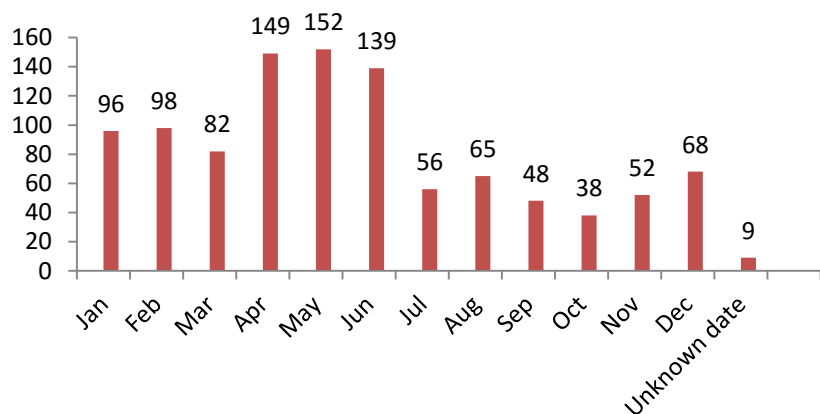


Executions in the Islamic Republic of Iran in 2015

EXECUTIONS: MORE THAN JUST NUMBERS

Behind the data on Iran's death penalty, human lives are being lost, families shattered, and children traumatized. The numbers reflect case upon case of tortured confessions, trials without the right to defense, public hangings, juvenile executions, and sentences that punish poverty, consensual sex, and political association.

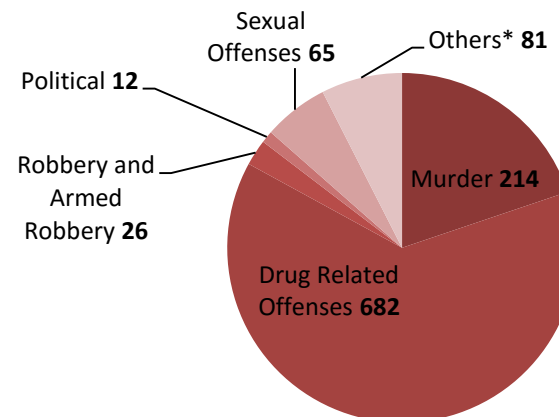
